We recognize that you're looking for more flexibility and options, so we want to share this Marriott Bonvoy program update with you.

ELITE STATUS EXTENDED THROUGH FEB. 2023

Your 2019 earned status, which we already renewed through February 2022, or your 2020 status, will be extended through February 2023. You'll continue to receive your Elite benefits when you travel again.

SUITE NIGHT AWARDS EXTENDED THROUGH JUNE 2022

In addition, we'll extend Suite Night Awards[™] (SNAs) with an expiration date of December 31, 2021, for an additional six months — to June 30, 2022.

PAUSING POINTS EXPIRATION THROUGH DEC. 2022

We'll pause the expiration of points through December 31, 2022. At that time, your points will only expire if your account has been inactive for at least 24 months. In the meantime, you can explore all the ways to keep your account active, including linking your Marriott Bonvoy and Uber accounts, buying points, and much more.

MORE REDEMPTION FLEXIBILITY

In March 2022, we'll introduce new [flexible point redemption rates](#) that move more closely in line with hotel rates, giving you even more options to choose from. Hotels and resorts will still have a minimum and maximum number of points for redemption rates that will more closely align to how they're categorized today.

Our current redemption process with hotel categories will remain in place through February 2022. After that, you won't see hotel categories (1–8) or redemption rates classified as Off-Peak, Peak, or Standard.

You'll continue to earn points all the same ways, including on stays with Homes and Villas by Marriott International and All-Inclusive by Marriott Bonvoy resorts. Now, you'll just have more flexibility when you're ready to redeem. [View FAQs](#).

FREE NIGHT AWARD FLEXIBILITY

We'll also extend¹ eligible Free Night Awards to June 30, 2022. We know how much you look forward to redeeming your Free Night Awards, and you now have more time to enjoy them. Certain hotels have resort fees. [Explore the possibilities](#).
